





CALL FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS - JANUARY 2025 INTAKE

Diploma in Nursing and Midwifery at Ekwendeni College of Health Sciences

Amref international University (AMIU), Amref Health Africa in Malawi and Ekwendeni College of Health Sciences (ECOHS) have partnered to offer 15 tuition scholarships to deserving girls to study for a Diploma in Nursing and Midwifery.

This scholarship will support girls from vulnerable households to have the opportunity to earn a Diploma in Nursing and Midwifery. The trained girls will then have the opportunity to serve in their respective communities and contribute to the wellbeing of women, girls, men and boys in Malawi.

The selected girls will be provided with a tuition of MK 1,061,600.00

Entry Requirements

Candidates should possess

• Full Malawi School Certificate Education (MSCE); OR its equivalent with four credits in English, Biology, Physical Science or Physics or Chemistry, PLUS a credit in one of the following science subjects; Mathematics, Agriculture, Home Economics, General science, or Geography

NOTE: If Mathematics is not a credit, it should at least be a strong pass of seven (7) points.

Eligibility for Scholarship

- Must be a girl aged between 18 and 25 years
- Proof of financial constraint by the family or guardians
- Proof of extra support for accommodation, transport and upkeep. Amref will only provide tuition.

Students who have already been selected for January 2025 intake are also eligible to apply for the scholarship.

Application process

Applicants meeting the above requirements should deposit K15,000.00 (fifteen thousand kwacha only) non-refundable registration fee to the following National Bank account details by 31 December 2024 and download and fill the application form on the college website: www.ecohs.ac.mw or https://www.ecohs.ac.mw or https://shorturl.at/qtLT7 or request via email at info.malawi@amref.org or collect the form from the campus.
