Ekwendeni College of Health Sciences is under the proprietorship of the CCAP Synod of Livingstonia. It exists to provide training of Health professionals within Christian Principles and Values. The College invites applicants to pursue the following programmes: Diploma in Nursing and Midwifery Technician (NMT), Diploma in Clinical Medicine, Certificate in Pharmacy and Diploma in Pharmacy.

DIPLOMA IN NURSING AND MIDWIFERY TECHNICIAN (3 YEARS)

Entry Requirements

- a. Candidates should be between 16-45 Years of age by the date of application.
- b. Candidates should possess a full Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with four credits in English, Biology and Physical Science or physics or chemistry plus one of the following science subjects Mathematics, Agriculture, Home Economics, General Science or Geography

NOTE: If Mathematics is not a credit, it should at least be a strong pass of seven points (7).

2. DIPLOMA IN CLINICAL MEDICINE (3 YEARS)

Entry Requirements

- a. Candidates should be between 17-45 Years of age by the date of application.
- b. Candidates should possess a full Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with six (6) credits in English, Mathematics, Biology and Physical Science or Physics and Chemistry plus any other two subjects

3. CERTIFICATE IN PHARMACY (2 YEARS)

Entry Requirements

- a. Candidates should be between 16-45 Years of age by the date of application.
- b. Candidates should possess a full Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with three credits in English, Mathematics,
 Physical Science or Chemistry or Biology. If English is not a credit then it must be a strong pass (7)

4. DIPLOMA IN PHARMACY (3 YEARS)

Entry Requirements

- a. Candidates must be between 16 and 45 years of age by the date of application
- b. Candidates must possess a full Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with six (6) credit passes including English, Mathematics, Biology and Physical Science/ General Science/ Physics and Chemistry plus any other two subjects.

Applicants meeting the above requirements should download our application forms from www.ecohs.ac.mw and fill and submit the form. Applicants must also deposit a MK15,000.00 non-refundable application processing fee to the following bank details:
