The College invites applicants to pursue the following programmes: University Certificate in Midwifery and Community Midwifery Assistant.

1. UNIVERSITY CERTIFICATE IN MIDWIFERY (1 YEAR)

Entry Requirements

- a. Candidates should possess a full Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with six credits including the following subjects: English, Mathematics, Biology and Physical Science or physics or chemistry plus any other two subjects.
- b. A holder of Diploma in Nursing or Degree in General Nursing

2. COMMUNITY MIDWIFERY ASSISTANT (18 MONTHS)

Entry Requirements

- a. The candidate should be between 20-45 Years
- b. The candidate should provide evidence of having passed Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) with a credit pass in English and Biology and a pass in either Physical Science or Physics or Chemistry or Mathematics
