

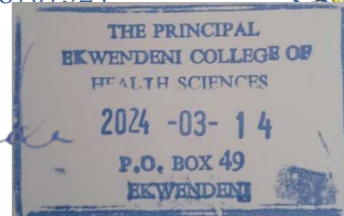

The college has recently been approved to start offering a Diploma in Pharmacy programme by the Pharmacy and Medicines Regulatory Authority (PMRA) to commence sometime this year. The College, therefore invites applications from suitably qualified candidates to pursue a three-year **Diploma in Pharmacy** and details are as follows;

PROGRAMME: Diploma in Pharmacy (3 years)

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- a. Candidates should be between 16- 45 Years of age by the date of application.
- b. Candidates should possess a full Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with Six (6) Credits passes including **English, Mathematics, Biology** and **Physical Science/General Science/ Chemistry** and **any other two subjects**.

Applicants meeting the above requirements should deposit K10, 000 non-refundable registration fee to National Bank of Malawi before 05th April, 2024 and download the application form from college website:

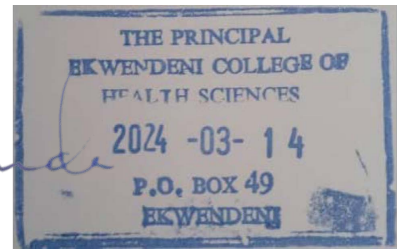

